



# Recycling at UWA

Facilities Management Environmental Services has implemented a number of recycling initiatives to reduce the amount of recyclable resources going to landfill.

## Commingled Recycling

Every staff member should have a labelled commingled recycle bin under their desk. You can recycle these items in the commingled bin:

- All types of paper and cardboard
- Glass Bottles and Jars (rinse & remove lids)
- Plastic beverage bottles (rinse & remove lids)
- Milk and juice cartons
- Aluminium cans
- Paper hand towels

## Polystyrene & Plastics

Polystyrene: Email [recycle@uwa.edu.au](mailto:recycle@uwa.edu.au) for bin location details or with a request for collecting bulk amounts.

Plastics: All types of plastic can be recycled on campus. Set up a plastics recycling bin in your office and when full empty in plastics bin. For bin location details or pick up of bulk amounts contact [recycle@uwa.edu.au](mailto:recycle@uwa.edu.au).

## Print & Toner Cartridges

Contact WA Toner Supplies on 9244 2905 and they can provide a recycle box. Alternatively they are here most days on campus and can pick up single cartridges if required.

## Mobile Phones

A mobile phone recycling box is located next to the Reid Library coffee shop. Bring in old mobiles from home/work which will then be reused or recycled. This initiative supports the Cerebral Palsy Association of WA.

## Cardboard

Flatten boxes and place in the large recycle wheelie bin (blue bin with red lid). Make sure all polystyrene and plastic is removed. There is also a large skip designated for cardboard located in Car Park 9. For large amounts call Cleaning ext 2004.

## Batteries

Battery collection containers are located at the UWA Workshops and Mechanical Engineering (level 1, near the stairwell). Contact Cleaning ext 2004 if you require pick up of multiple batteries.

## Computers & Printers

## Food waste
